What to Bring

Each day ensure that your child has:

- **A labeled spill proof cup** filled with water for their lunch kit. We do have cone cups for water during the day.
- **A labeled lunch kit** with their lunch and afternoon snack including an ice pack to be placed on the rolling carts. (30 sec. heat up is ok). Heat ups to be placed in the red tray. Food should come precut/fully prepared please.
- Morning snack is provided to the group on a rotation by each family
- **We will label containers with marker that do not have a name. We will also do this with clothes.**
- **Diapers/pull ups** unless trained (SIDE OPENING only)
- A labeled sweater and hat.
- A labeled **jacket** (no buttons) • Indoor shoes only if wet outside.
- Labeled stuffie/soother/blanket for naptime (items go home weekly for laundering)
- One or more labeled **changes of clothes** to stay in their locker. Include socks (and underwear if they wear them.)

- **Plan for us to go outside each day**, just in case the weather changes after you leave home. Labeled mittens, toque, ski pants, splash pants, boots, etc. should accompany your child each day, depending on the season.
- **Wipe refills** on day one and upon request



Other things to consider

- **Expect** that as your child experiences art, the outdoors, and their food, they are going to get **messy**. Please dress them accordingly, and feel free to save their nicest outfits for other places.
- **Your child is probably going to be sick several times this year.** Please review our policy guidelines on fevers, etc. and always have a back-up plan so that they can stay at home when needed. We do sanitize the entire room constantly; but the reality is they cough and sneeze into the faces of others. Please join us in teaching them to **cough into their elbows**, it's never too early!
- **Pushing and hitting happens occasionally** in group care at this age. We do our best to watch for it. We problem solve what else they could have done, encourage the use of words, and encourage empathy.
- Expect that **toys from home** may go missing and get broken. Staff will not have time to help locate lost toys from home. We will label with permanent marker.
- Snack calendars will be emailed monthly. Please check to make sure the dates work for you. Days can be switched.
- Art bins are in the room and should be checked daily for art work to go home. We do year end art journals so some art work is saved for that.
